Names Behind the Libations

Bill Fairweather & Old Antelope

Bill discovered Alder Gulch May 26, 1863, along with Henry Edgar setting off a stampede. The gulch made him rich but he preferred riding his horse, Old Antelope up and down the streets of Virginia City scattering gold dust for the kids to find. He died before he was 40 but his horse lived on and put out to pasture at an extreme old age.

Jack Slade

Jack was a stagecoach and Pony Express superintendent. He had a reputation as a "gunfighter". In a drunken spree in Virginia City, he was lynched by local vigilantes March 10, 1864. He was preserved in alcohol for his trip to his final burial place in Salt Lake City.

Varina Davis

The original name for Virginia City was Varina. To be named for Varina Howell Davis, the First Lady of the Confederate State of America during the American Civil War. However, when registration was filed a Connecticut judge, G.G. Bissell objected and chose to record the name as Virginia City.

Mattie Lee

Long time Madam in Virginia City. Trouble usually followed these ladies and in 1903 she was sent to prison for shooting a man in a bar fight in Philipsburg over \$10. Her only known photograph is her mug shot.

Joseph Mallard

Banker and co-founder of the Allen & Mallard Bank. He served in the US Senate and as a Mayor of Omaha, NE. He lived in Virginia City from 1864 -1866. The Allen & Mallard Bank is documented as the first bank in Montana and the original safe still stands in the historic building.
